INVITATION TO TENDER

Briston Parish Council requires a contractor to cut the following areas from mid April to the end of October 2021

1. Village Green

Large grassed area surrounded by trees. Needs gang mower and ride on mower to carry out cut.

2. Recreation Ground

Playing field – large grassed area. Needs gang mower
Children’s Play Area and Skate Park

2. Bakery Close

Open space with some trees

3. Plantation Hill Estate

Garden Close

Large grassed area – cut round all trees and through the ones in the centre

Back of Garden Close – footpath running down to allotments entrance

Cut all this area down to the entrance to the allotments. Cut grass to within one foot of base of trees along one side and close to fences on the other.

Grassed area between Bridge Close and Jewel Close

Grassed area behind Bridge Close running down to the Fakenham Road

Large grassed area to be cut to within one foot of all trees and fences

Wellington Road outside numbers 23 and 25

Grassed area

Cut through between Wellington Road and Garden Close including large grassed area

Wellington Road area up to and round flag pole and memorial to airmen

Requirements

Harrow and roll in spring large grassed areas

Mow twice per month from mid March to the end of October inclusive

Scarify/aerate at start of contract

Contractors are asked to quote for each numbered section separately.
Please give a cost for the work to be carried out from mid April to the end of October 2020 exclusive of VAT
Contractors may quote for all of the grass cutting or specific items only.
Contractors must provide all their own labour and equipment to carry out all work.
It is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that all their staff is fully trained, compliant with all health and safety legislative and insured.
Briston Parish Council will pay for the work in two half's, from the chosen contractor/s on production of an invoice at the end of June and the end of October 2021.
The contract awarded to successful contractor/s will run for one year from mid April to the end of October 2021. There may be an opportunity to extend the contract for a further two years if the work is carried out to the satisfaction of Briston Parish Council
Quotations must be submitted on the attached form and returned by post or email to Jenny English at the address at the start of this Invitation to Tender.

The closing date for completed tenders to be returned is 26 February 2021

The successful contractor will be informed in March 2021 with the first cut to be carried out during week commencing Monday 12 April 2021.
