

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C267 Reepham Road from 190m south of its junction with Mill Lane and Thurning Road for 20m southwards in the PARISH OF BRISTON because of Anglian Water new connection works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> April 2022 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: C267 Reepham Road/Hall Street/Church Street, B1354 Holt Road/Wood Dalling Road/Briston Road, C228 Heydon Road, Norwich Road, Valley Road, B1149 Link Road, Aylsham Road (Heydon, Wood Dalling, Thurning, Briston, Corpusty and Saxthorpe, Cawston, Salle).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
