

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting C267 Church Street from 148m southeast of its junction with Old Post Office Road for 20m south-eastwards in the PARISH OF BRISTON because of electrical works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 12th to 18th April 2022 for the duration of the works expected to be about 7 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: C267 Church Street, B1354 Holt Road/Norwich Road/Briston Road, B1149 Aylsham Road/Link Road roundabout/Link Road, C477 Valley Road/Horseshoe Lane/Wood Dalling Road/Corpusty Road/Crow Hill, C267 Reepham Road/Hall Street (Heydon, Wood Dalling, Thurning, Briston, Corpusty & Saxthorpe).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
