

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO6328) prohibiting the use by vehicles of Thurning Road from 24m east of its junction with Reepham Road for 1090m south-eastwards in the PARISH OF BRISTON to facilitate new duct and joint boxes construction works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 13th to 24th March 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 12 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Thurning Road, Saxthorpe Road, Corpusty Road, Sandy Lane, Wood Dalling Road, Reepham Road (Thurning, Briston).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
